- Provide schedule analysis and metrics to key stakeholders on a regular basis
- Maximizing efficiency of the project strategy with respect to cost, time and contingency
- Work with the Operations Manager to develop and maintain an area project schedule monitoring and implementation strategy.
- Incorporate resource and cost loading data into schedules as required
- Assist Project Managers and Superintendents in creating short-term schedules and monitoring these schedules to determine their impact on the master schedule
- Maintain the master schedule for project and identify and record the impact of work performed according to the schedule. Evaluate construction progress and provide regular schedule updates
- Management of all tasks, activities, and time management resources related to time planning, scheduling, monitoring, and control for the Centre Block Rehabilitation program,



including aspects that influence the design and in continuous coordination with the cost and risk services.
