Plumber (Red Seal)

Role Scope:

The Plumber (Red Seal) plays a key role in supporting the Production Manager in overseeing and coordinating the day-to-day plumbing operations of the Shop production floor. The Plumber will be expected to be hands on working closely with the production team, providing direction, support, and training to ensure smooth workflows and consistent output. Job Responsibilities:

- Install, repair, and maintain plumbing systems, including water, and waste systems, in mobile/ portable shipping container solutions, shipboard solutions and permanent/ fixed systems.
- Diagnose and troubleshoot plumbing issues, including leaks, clogs, and system malfunctions, and implement effective solutions.
- Ensure all work complies with the Ontario Building Code, local plumbing regulations, and safety standards.
- Maintain accurate records of work performed, including materials used and time spent on tasks.
- Provide excellent customer service, communicating clearly with clients and addressing their concerns.
- Maintain tools, equipment, and work vehicles in good condition, ensuring a clean and safe work environment.
